Amendment 3

Smoother, Safer, Sooner

- Currently MoDOT is not performing PM. Instead our focus is on the Amendment 3 Smoother, Safer, Sooner program.
- With the passage of Amendment 3, in November 2004, Missouri roadways will soon see improvements of smoother pavements, brighter stripes and signs, improved shoulders with rumble stripes and safer guardrail.
- Only 46% of Missouri's roads are in good condition.

Smother, Safer, Sooner

- 3 Elements

- 1-Smooth Roads Initiative (\$360M)
- 2-Accelerated Projects (\$430M)
- 3-Selecting New High-Priority Projects (est. 1.5B)

Amendment 3

Smother, Safer, Sooner

- Element 1 – SRI
 - Affects 2,200 miles of State roadway
 - 60% of the VMT
 - About 86% of Missouri's population lives within 10 miles of one of the selected roads

Amendment 3

Smother, Safer, Sooner

- Element 2 – Accelerated Projects
 - Major Projects that were scheduled to begin in the next 5 years can be accelerated into 2005, 2006 or 2007
 - Resurfacing and Rehabilitation Projects that are in the 2,200 miles of the SRI

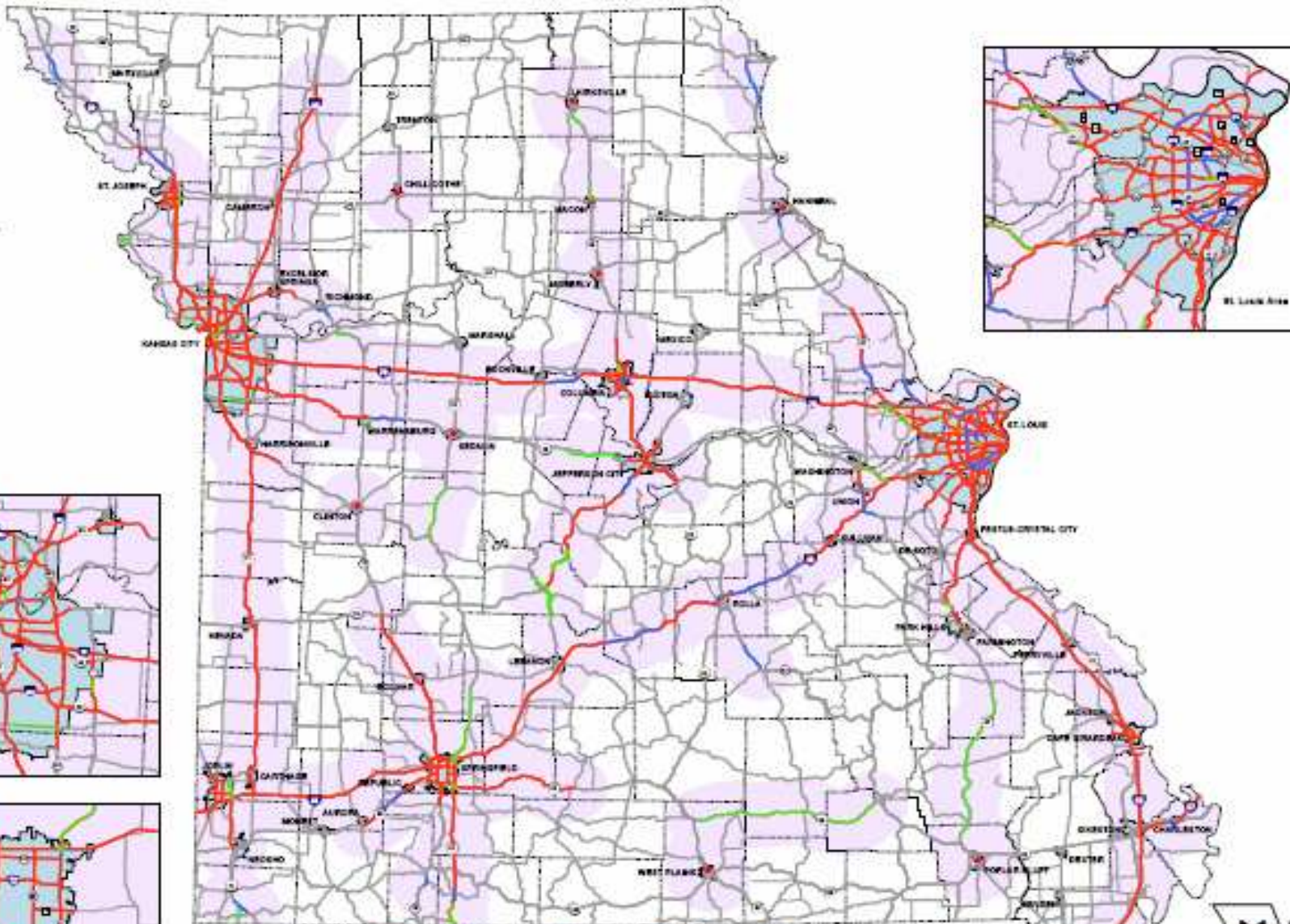

Smother, Safer, Sooner

- Element 3 – Selecting New High Priority Projects
 - Staff worked with planning partners around the State to determine highest priorities in each district.
 - Those priorities have been agreed upon and letting of these projects will be coming soon.

AMENDMENT 3 PROJECTS

- ELEMENT 1 - SMOOTH ROADS INITIATIVE PROJECTS
 - ELEMENT 2 - ACCELERATED CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS
 - ELEMENT 3 - NEW MAJOR CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS
- 82% OF MISSOURI'S POPULATION LIVES WITHIN A 10-MILE RADIUS
