Background

The combined experience that our members possess will help focus training on the immediate pavement preservation needs of the county and municipal government agency. Training Courses

Training courses are offered various times throughout the year. Courses are taught by national experts to provide you with the latest best practices on a wide range of Pavement Preservation topics that include:

- Micro Surfacing/Slurry Seal
- Chip seals
- Rejuvenator and Fog seals
- Basic Concepts for Pavement Preservation
- Applied Asset Management

These workshops provide information on basic pavement preservation concepts and implementation. The information will be introduced to agency staff and elected officials who may be struggling with current budget constraints. The information is designed to address the needs of their highway/street network. The benefits of preservation treatments will be reviewed, and information shared. When the treatments are pro-actively applied to sound pavements there will be improved pavement performance, longer pavement life and increased customer satisfaction. Courses qualify for Continuing Education Units (CEUs).
