

## Montana DOT Best Practices for COVID-19

Q: What specific things are you doing to ensure social distancing in your shops and parts operations?

A: We have mechanics working some different shifts and possibly working at a maintenance shop or yard to keep social distancing. We are staggering lunch and breaks so that they don't all congregate in a small room.

Q: Do you have any specific instructions for sanitizing vehicles?

A: We are developing instruction and should have them done soon.

Q: Any other relevant information or practices you are using to keep employees safe and prevent the spread of the virus specific to shops and parts operations environment?

A: We have locked some shop doors and have set out bins for parts delivery so that delivery people are kept out of the shop. We have signs up keeping vendors from stopping in. We are getting shops ready to handle additional work in case all the mechanics in a shop are quarantined. We are working with all the shops to try and find sources for disinfecting chemicals. Some are having a hard time keeping disinfectants in stock and getting orders filled.
