

What is the Midwestern Pavement Preservation Partnership?

The Midwestern Pavement Preservation Partnership (MPPP) is a regional forum of pavement professionals from State and Provincial Agencies, Contractors, Suppliers, Academia, Local and Federal Government Officials, all working together to take advantage of the synergy to be gained from sharing information and identifying common issues for further investigation. It provides a forum to share and publicize information describing improvements in research, design, specifications, materials and construction practices, and to promote the benefits of Pavement Preservation through education and application.

When and where will the Partnership Meeting be held?

The partnership meeting will be held in St. Louis, Missouri at the Adam's Mark Hotel. The hotel is located in the downtown area and provides many sightseeing opportunities.

Training Opportunities

The NCPP Chip Seal Best Practices class is a one day class that will be taught on Tuesday, September 26th from 1–5 p.m. & on Wednesday, September 27th from 9 a.m.–12 p.m.

The NHI Pavement Preservation: Integrating Pavement Preservation Practices and Pavement Management will be taught in a day and a half. It will be taught on Tuesday, September 26th from 8 a.m. – 5 p.m. & on Wednesday, September 27th from 8 a.m. – 12 p.m.

What are the MPPP Registration Procedures?

Membership Benefits in the MPPP

You are encouraged to become a member of the MPPP, but membership is not required. Below is an explanation of membership guidelines and costs, as well as non-member prices.

State and Provincial members will receive travel and registration reimbursements for two voting participants who will also be eligible to serve as officers.

Local and Federal Government Officials and Academic members will receive paid registration for four participants who will also be eligible to serve as officers and one vote on issues being considered at the business meeting.

Industry members will each receive one paid exhibitor display space, paid registration for three participants who will also be eligible to serve as officers, and one vote on issues being considered at the business meeting. Membership for Industry members is coordinated by the Foundation for Pavement Preservation (FP2). Please make your check Payable to FP2 and return to the address listed on the registration form.

Member organization may register additional participants for \$200 / person.

Non-member organization may register participants at \$300 / person and purchase one exhibitor space for 300.
