

What is the Midwestern Pavement Preservation Partnership?

The Midwestern Pavement Preservation Partnership (MPPP) is a regional forum of pavement professionals from State and Provincial Agencies, Contractors, Suppliers, Academia, Local and Federal Government Officials, all working together to take advantage of the synergy to be gained from sharing information and identifying common issues for further investigation. It provides a forum to share and publicize information describing improvements in research, design, specifications, materials and construction practices, and to promote the benefits of Pavement Preservation through education and application.

When and where will the Partnership Meeting be held?

The partnership meeting will be held in Missoula, Montana at the Doubletree Hotel. The hotel is located in the downtown area and provides many sightseeing opportunities.

The NCPP Microsurfacing/Slurry Seal Best Practices Course will be taught on Tuesday, October 23rd from 9 a.m. –3 p.m. The NHI Pavement Preservation Course on Selecting Good Candidate Projects for Preventive Maintenance will be taught on Tuesday, October 23rd from 8 a.m. – 5 p.m.

We will also be offering a free education seminar on Monday afternoon that will present the findings of the FHWA/FP2 Sealer Binder study.

What are the MPPP Registration Procedures?

Membership Benefits in the MPPP

You are encouraged to become a member of the MPPP, but membership is not required. Below is an explanation of membership guidelines and costs, as well as non-member prices.

State and Provincial members will receive travel and registration reimbursements for two voting participants who will also be eligible to serve as officers. Please fill out the attached registration form and fax it to the NCPP at (517)432-8223. Indicate your travel preferences and we will contact you to coordinate.

Local and Federal Officials and Academic members will receive paid registration for four participants who will also be eligible to serve as officers and one vote on issues being considered at the business meeting.

Industry members will be eligible to serve as officers, and one vote on issues being considered at the business meeting. Registration fees will be at the discounted rate of \$250/person and exhibitor space will be available at the discounted rate of \$100.

Member organization may register additional participants for \$250 / person.

Non-member organization may register participants at \$350 / person and purchase one exhibitor space for \$250.
