What is the Midwestern Pavement Preservation Partnership?

The Midwestern Pavement Preservation Partnership (MPPP) is a regional forum of pavement professionals from State and Provincial Agencies, Contractors, Suppliers, Academia, Local and Federal Government Officials, all working together to take advantage of the synergy to be gained from sharing information and identifying common issues for further investigation. It provides a forum to share and publicize information describing improvements in research, design, specifications, materials and construction practices, and to promote the benefits of Pavement Preservation through education and application.

When and where will the Partnership Meeting be held?

The partnership meeting will be held in Minneapolis, Minnesota at the Hilton Minneapolis/St. Paul Airport hotel. The hotel is located in the Mall of America area and provides many sightseeing opportunities and a free shuttle to and from the airport and mall.

Training Opportunities

TWO TRAINING CLASSES ARE BEING OFFERED AT NO COST TO MEMBERS OF THE MPPP. Class sizes are limited, so please register early. Continuing Education Credits are offered for both courses.

A modified NHI Pavement Preservation Course **Making Pavement Preservation Programs Work**. This interactive, problem-solving 1-day workshop will be held immediately prior to the start of the 2008 Midwest Pavement Preservation Partnership (MPPP) meeting in Minneapolis. The workshop begins at 1:00 PM on the afternoon of September 8th and concludes at noon on September 9th. The workshop builds on the topics covered in NHI Courses 131104, *Pavement Preservation: Integrating Pavement Preservation and Pavement Management* and 131115, *Pavement Preservation: Treatment, Timing, and Selection*, both of which have been offered at previous MPPP meetings. Participants will have the opportunity to hear about current practices, address specific challenges, and develop strategies for enhancing their programs in each of the following areas: Evaluating Preventive Maintenance Treatment Performance; Identifying and Addressing Pavement Preservation Data Needs for Project and Treatment Selection; Demonstrating the Benefits of Pavement Preservation.

Overcoming Institutional Barriers to Support Pavement Preservation. The course will be split into two separate modules, allowing people to attend this class the first day and the NCPP "Top of the Curve": class the next if desired.

The NCPP offers "Top of the Curve" a course designed to cover the earliest pavement preservation treatments and best practices of rejuvenation, fog sealing, crack sealing and crack filling. The class will be presented Tuesday, September 9th from 8:00 AM to 12:00 Noon.
