## ***What is the Rocky Mountain Pavement Preservation Partnership (RMPPP)?***

The Rocky Mountain Pavement Preservation Partnership is a regional forum of pavement professionals from State and Provincial Agencies, Contractors, Suppliers, Academia, Local and Federal Government Officials, all working together to take advantage of the synergy to be gained from sharing information and identifying common issues for further investigation. It provides a forum to share and publicize information describing improvements in research, design, specifications, materials and construction practices, and to promote the benefits of Pavement Preservation through education and application.

## **When and where will the Partnership Meeting be held?**

The partnership meeting will be held in Albuquerque, New Mexico at the Albuquerque Marriott Hotel. The hotel is located in the Uptown Business District of Albuquerque and provides many sightseeing opportunities.

## **Membership Benefits in the RMPPP**

You are encouraged to become a member of the RMPPP, but membership is not required. Below is an explanation of membership guidelines and costs, as well as non-member prices.

**State and Provincial members** will receive travel and registration reimbursements for two voting participants who will also be eligible to serve as officers.

**Local and Federal Government Officials and Academic members** will become automatic members with paid registration at the rate of \$250 a person. You will also be eligible to serve as officers and one vote on issues being considered at the business meeting.

**Industry members** will each receive one paid exhibitor display space, paid registration for two participants who will also be eligible to serve as officers, and one vote on issues being considered at the business meeting.

**Member organization** may register additional participants for \$250 / person.

**Non-member organization** may register participants at \$350 / person and purchase one exhibitor space for \$700.
