Local and Academic members will receive paid registration for four participants who will also be eligible to serve as officers and one vote on issues being considered at the business meeting for a fee of \$800.00.

Industry members will be eligible to serve as officers, and one vote on issues being considered at the business meeting. Registration fees will be at the discounted rate of \$250/person and exhibitor space will be available at the discounted rate of \$250.
