What is the Midwest Bridge Preservation Partnership (MWBPP)?

The Midwest Bridge Preservation Partnership is a regional forum comprised of bridge practitioners from State and Local Agencies, Contractors, Suppliers, Academia, and Federal Government Officials in a sharing of bridge preservation practices throughout the Midwest Region. The gathering provides a forum to discuss bridge preservation strategies, including treatments; management; inspection; improvements in research, design, specifications, and materials; and to promote the benefits of Bridge Preservation through education and application.

When and where will the Partnership Meeting be held?

The partnership meeting will be held November 11-13th, 2013 in Indianapolis, Indiana at the Westin Indianapolis, located at 50 S Capitol Ave.

Membership Benefits in the MBPP

You are encouraged to become a member of the MWBPP, but membership is not required. Below is an explanation of membership guidelines and costs, as well as non-member pricing.

State Membership Each state will receive travel, lodging, and registration for two voting participants who will also be eligible to serve as officers.

Local and Federal Government Officials and Academic Memberships will become automatic with paid registration at the rate of \$300 per person. You will also be eligible to serve as an officer and have one vote on issues being considered at the business meeting.

Regional Industry Membership will receive one paid exhibitor display space, paid registrations for two participants who will also be eligible to serve as officers, and one vote on issues being considered at the business meeting.

National Industry Members will receive one paid exhibitor display space, paid registrations for two participants who will also be eligible to serve as officers, and one vote on issues being considered at the business meeting.

Member organizations may register additional participants for \$300 / person.

Non-member organizations may register participants at \$400 / person and/or purchase one exhibitor space for \$700.
