A Bridge Discussion Items

1 Bridge Preservation Expert Task Group (BPETG)

George Hearn, the Partnership's Academic representative also represents the Partnership on the BPETG, which also has members representing SCOBS, SCOM, FHWA, the three TRB committees dealing with bridge preservation, and Industry.

2 SCOM Representation

3 NHI Bridge Maintenance Course

Chris Keegan attended this course in Lansing, Michigan. Although the course was good, it focused more on the "what" and "why" rather than the "how". The bridge crews wanted to know how to do their work and

whether there was any better equipment, materials or methods that they could use. They had not heard of the Stop Crack X tool. They did show a small barge that they built, which had a hopper in the middle that could be filled with rock and floated to where the rock needed to be placed. After a handle was pulled, the rock was deposited through a hatch in the bottom of the barge.
