## 2019 Northeast Bridge Preservation Partnership Annual Meeting

<u>What is TSP-2?</u> The Transportation System Preservation Technical Services Program (*TSP-2*) was initiated as an efficient means to disseminate information to AASHTO member agencies for preserving their highway infrastructure, including both pavements and bridges. Its principal mission is to serve as a clearinghouse with comprehensive and up-to-date information on efficient and effective preservation measures that enhance highway performance and extend useful life.

What is the Northeast Bridge Preservation Partnership (NEBPP)? The Northeast Bridge Preservation Partnership is a regional forum comprised of bridge practitioners from State. Local and Federal Government Agencies, Contractors, Consultants, Suppliers, Academia, and Canadian Provinces where bridge preservation practices throughout the Northeast Region are shared. You are encouraged to become a member of the NEBPP, but membership is not required to attend the 2019 annual meeting.

<u>State transportation agencies</u>: through the AASHTO TSP-2 yearly, voluntary contribution, state member agencies may send two participants and receive travel, lodging, registration, and expense reimbursement for those participants to attend the 2019 annual meeting.

<u>Provincial agencies</u>: for payment of a \$4,500 fee, provincial member agencies may send two participants and receive travel, lodging, registration, and expense reimbursement for those two participants to attend the 2019 annual meeting.

(New in 2019) Local agencies: for payment of a \$2,250 fee, local member agencies may send one participant and receive travel, lodging, registration, and expense reimbursement for that one participant to attend the 2019 annual meeting.

<u>Industry members</u> will each receive one paid exhibitor display space and table plus paid registration for two participants who will also be eligible to serve as officers. Elected industry officers may cast one vote on issues being considered at the business meeting. National membership in the Bridge Preservation Partnerships allows these benefits at each of the four regional partnership meetings. Regional membership in the Northeast Bridge Preservation Partnership allows these benefits for this meeting only. <u>New for 2019!!!
