What is the Rocky Mountain West Pavement Preservation Partnership (RMWPPP)?

The Rocky Mountain West Pavement Preservation Partnership is a regional forum of pavement professionals from State and Provincial Agencies, Contractors, Suppliers, Academia, Local and Federal Government Officials, all working together to take advantage of the synergy to be gained from sharing information and identifying common issues for further investigation. It provides a forum to share and publicize information describing improvements in research, design, specifications, materials and construction practices, and to promote the benefits of Pavement Preservation through education and application. You are encouraged to become a member of the RMWPPP, but membership is not required to attend the meeting.

Where will the Partnership Meeting be held?

The partnership meeting will be held in Park City, Utah at the Park City Marriott/Sheridan, located at 1895 Sidewinder Dr., Park City, UT.

Membership Categories:

State transportation agencies: through the AASHTO TSP-2 yearly, voluntary contribution, state member agencies may send two participants and receive travel, lodging, registration, and expense reimbursement for those participants to attend the 2019 annual meeting.

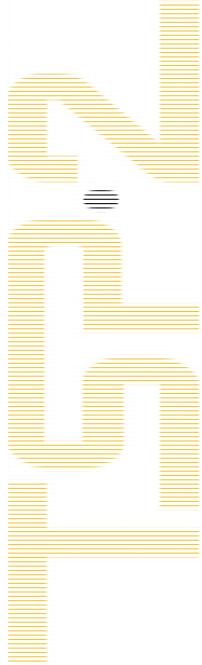
Provincial agencies: for payment of a \$4,500 fee, provincial member agencies may send two participants and receive travel, lodging, registration, and expense reimbursement for those two participants to attend the 2019 annual meeting.

(New in 2019) Local agencies: for payment of a \$2,250 fee, local member agencies may send one participant and receive travel, lodging, registration, and expense reimbursement for that one participant to attend the 2019 annual meeting.

Industry members will each receive one paid exhibitor display space and table plus paid registration for two participants who will also be eligible to serve as officers. Elected industry officers may cast one vote on issues being considered at the business meeting. National membership in the Preservation Partnerships allows these benefits at each of the four regional partnership meetings. Regional membership in the RMWPPP allows these benefits for this meeting only.
